Information from Bans Off Our Bodies – Moscow

Abortion is still legal in Idaho. The full ban goes into effect in 30 days (July 24th) with limited exceptions in cases of rape, incest, or if the life of the pregnant person is at risk.

Abortion is still legal in Washington and has been protected by state law since 1970. Abortions are available in the state depending on the length of your pregnancy among other factors.
